Another Tribute to HHL: Government Releases Postage Stamp

A postage stamp in honour of Henning Holck-Larsen (HHL), co-founder of L&T, was released by the Department of Posts on June 12, 2008 in New Delhi. The Rs. 5 denominated stamp was released by Union Minister for Communication & Information Technology, Mr. A. Raja, in the presence of Secretary (Posts), Mrs. Radhika Doraiswamy and Mr. A. M. Naik, Chairman & Managing Director of L&T.
